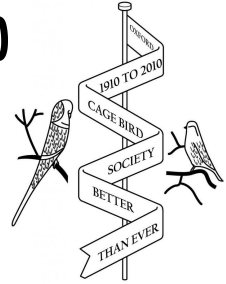

SHOW RULES

A ticked bird is one with a mark coverable with a new penny on an otherwise clear body, wings or tail.

Variegated cinnamons are to be shown in the variegated classes.

Breeders classes: birds in the budgerigar breeder classes must be wearing the official closed coded ring of the exhibitor with the current year, such a ring to have been purchased from the budgerigar society.

All British birds to conform to D.O.E. Regulations.

All specimens to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor at least fourteen days before the show. No exhibitor is allowed to exhibit the same specimen in more than one class. No bird shall be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased within four months of the show, to which they (the judge) has been appointed.

For budgerigar sections only specialist society rules supersede these rules.

All birds for sale must go in Sales Classes. No birds to be offered for sale without the knowledge of the Sales Stewards Norman Cox & Bob Honey.

Current year bred birds must be rung where applicable. Following plaques to be awarded to fully paid up members: Best Budgerigar Young Bird, Best Canary Unflighted, Best British Unflighted, Best Zebra Young Bird, Best Foreign Young Bird, Best Bengalese Young Bird and Best Junior Exhibit Young Bird.

Avian Influenza

SCHEDULE OF GENERAL LICENCE CONDITIONS

The following licence conditions will apply to bird gatherings (except pigeon races taking place within the British Isles only).

Where conditions 7-11 apply and falconry events where conditions 12-18 apply

1. A nominated person must be designated as the event organiser and a person responsible for keeping the records set out in condition 2.
2. A record of all attendees must be kept for three months which includes the following information.
 - a) Full name
 - b) Home address
 - c) Telephone Number
 - d) Number and types of birds
3. A named veterinary surgeon (or another veterinary surgeon. If the named person is unavailable) must be contactable for advice and to attend in the event of any suspect disease.
4. Biosecurity advice must be distributed at the event.
5. If sales of birds are taking place at the event, a record of all sales must be kept by the event organiser for at least three months. This must include the name, address and telephone number of both the seller and the buyer, and any identifying features or individual identification of the purchased bird(s)
6. To notify the local State Veterinary Service Animal Health Office nearest to the event at least 14 days prior to the event taking place. Notification must include date, location, details of the event organiser and anticipated numbers and types of birds.
